Recently, a research project called 'Municipal school services at preschool and compulsory schools: Policy, framework, financing and practices' was launched. It is led by the University of Akureyri, and the participants are Hermína Gunnþórsdóttir, Birna María Svanbjörnsdóttir, Jórunn Elídóttir, Laufey Petrea Magnúsdóttir, Trausti Þorsteinsson, Rúnar Sigþórsson, and Sigríður Margrét Sigurðardóttir. The study has received grants from the Ministry of Education and the Research Fund of the University of Akureyri.

The aim of the study is reflected in its name, but we are particularly interested in examining the practice and nature of school services at each location.
