NordFlexOn aims to:

- Identify potential and current challenges for the uptake and development of OFDL in the Nordic region
- Advocate for quality OFDL in Nordic countries and beyound
- Facilitate cross-country collaboration and disseminate practice-based and research-based knowledge on OFDL across the Nordic region

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






Starting an Icelandic Associations for Distance and digital Learning

University of Iceland – School of Education (with a long history of DE in teahcer education) – is leading this work










Brainstorming Meeting, Iceland June 2023



111 in 36 workplaces invited to a meeting 35 (32%) attended from 12 workplaces



Should we create association in Iceland for distance and digital learning



Yes, association for distance and digital learning (71%),

Yes but not sure whether it should be for DE only or also for digital learning (21%); Yes association for DE (only) (4%), Not sure (4%)






What should be the purpose and aim?

Target groups

- Main target group
 - Individuals (assocatiated w different school levels and adult education)
- Other target groups
 - Informal educational entities in the area of adult educaton,
 - Work places and associations,
 - Formal institutions and/or school departments





The associations should be a forum:

- For collaboration:
 - Different institutions and educators
 - To share knowledge about what does and doesn' work
 - Between similar associations in the Nordic countries and beyond





Knowledge, ideas, technology, method, development in the area of DE and DL

- To advocate
- To increase our understanding of DE
- To share the latest teaching methods and techologies
- To share experiences
- To seek and provide support
- To find the latest research results
- To discuss the quality of DE





New ODFL assocation should be

- Forum for dissemination and collaboration.
- Host events
- Support and draw attention to research and development, e.g. regarding quality of OFDL, technologies and pedagogies.
- Increase visibility of OFDL
- Create pressure for government regarding OFDL-related policy.

Conclusions and further work

There appears to be need for an association for DE in Iceland

Preparation group started work in October with the aim to create the association before the end of 2023.





Key topics raised as relevant for the Nordic region and linked to the topic of lifelong learning



- Ecology of learning education and learning as an ecosystem
- The importance of open, flexible, and distance learning for lifelong learning
- Technical and new skill requirements in the new labour market
- Accessibility and inclusion in education through flexible education
- Learning cycles (lifelong/lifewide).
- Integration of sustainable development goals into institutional strategies
